

Becoming a Governor of the Stamford Endowed Schools

There are 18 governors of the Stamford Endowed Schools and usually a couple of vacancies occur each year. The Chair of Governors is always keen to hear from those who might be interested in joining the governing body and expressions of interest are welcome.

The main qualifications include:

- That you are interested in and fully committed to the success of our Schools.
- Wisdom and useful experience. We ensure we have a number of key skills on our governing body including in primary, secondary, tertiary and post graduate education, finance, business, estates, marketing, human resources, IT and law.
- Time. You will need to attend the full Governors' meetings at the end of each term and the strategy meeting in October. You may join one of our committees and there are other roles that may attract you such as school liaison governor. You will need to keep abreast of the information presented to governors and be well prepared for meetings.
- Familiarity with the Schools. This can be achieved by visiting the Schools, tours, attending co-curricular events.
- Familiarity with the world of education and the pressures and issues affecting schools, particularly independent schools.
